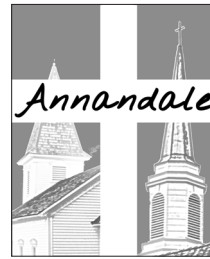

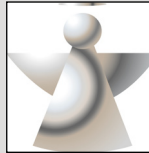
# Coming Soon
