The Youth Choir will be meeting TODAY, 12:15-1 p.m., in the Choir Room for ALL 6-12 grade students. Come and join us!!!

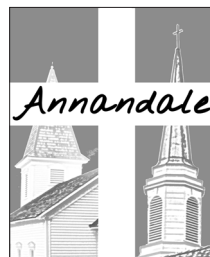
