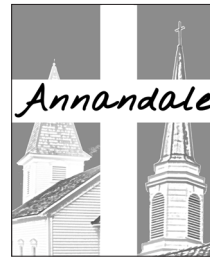

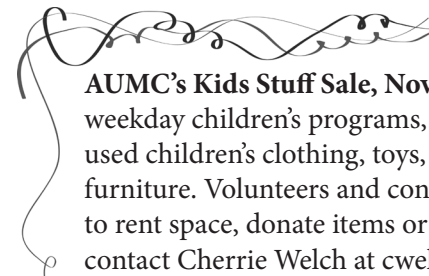

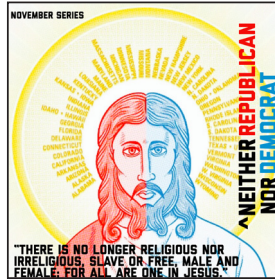

November sermon series:

Neither Republican nor Democrat

Diversity of views is not an obstacle to be overcome but is itself a sign of the gospel. In a time when our culture is balkanized by labels and loyalties, the grace of God creates communities where those worldly distinctions can exist in submission to the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Our three-week sermon series is based on Paul's letter to the Galatians. Here are the topics for each week:

Today: "No Other Gospel" (Gal. 1:3-9) – The Church's primary mission is to proclaim the gospel of grace in worship, word and work.

Nov. 11: "Faith Alone" (Gal. 2:16, 3:23-29) – The church grows together in faith in order to trust in God's doing for us, grace, and not our own doing, the law.

Nov. 18: "Free for Our Neighbors" (Gal. 5:1-6, 13-15) – The church is set free to serve our neighbors as ambassadors of the gospel.
